#### Sub-Category: **General Knowledge and Skills**




Introductory	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Launches a browser and uses the tool bar</li> <li>- Specifies a URL and can point and click to navigate on existing links</li> <li>- Changes window sizes</li> <li>- Views history</li> <li>- Accesses help file</li> <li>- Explains basic internet terminology</li> <li>- Accesses Internet through a modem or network</li> </ul>
Intermediate	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Explains the anatomy of a URL</li> <li>- Configures preferences for software</li> <li>- Sets a home page</li> <li>- Refreshes or reloads a page</li> <li>- Hides, displays or configures the tool bar</li> <li>- Locates and opens a local file within the browser</li> <li>- Copies, pastes and saves from web pages</li> <li>- Downloads files</li> <li>- Configures page setup to print citation resources</li> </ul>
Proficient	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Selects helper files/applications used to open downloaded files</li> <li>- Maintains and organizes bookmarks/favorites</li> <li>- Troubleshoots address errors (i.e. 404 errors)</li> <li>- Uses and manages multiple windows</li> </ul>

#### Sub-Category: **Communication and Collaboration**

Introductory	- Explains use of email as a means of communication
Intermediate	- Uses email to communicate with members of a group
Proficient	- Explains the use of chat, newsgroups, or threaded discussions to communicate with members of a group

#### Sub-Category: **Research Tools**

Introductory	- Conducts basic searches
Intermediate	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Explains the differences between search indexes, search engines and metasearch tools</li> <li>- Understands Boolean logic</li> <li>- Conducts natural language searches</li> </ul>
Proficient	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Uses advanced search features</li> <li>- Conducts multiple search strategies to locate and validate information</li> <li>- Uses internet search as a resource for lesson development</li> </ul>

Sub-Category: <b>Ethics and Policies</b> 	
Intermediate	- Explains issues surrounding Internet use in the classroom (e.g. copyright, management, student safety, AUP, etc.)
Proficient	- Implements procedures and management techniques concerning Internet use in the classroom for instruction
Sub-Category: <b>Information Literacy</b> 	
Introductory	- Evaluates information for accuracy - Identifies whether a source is credible
Intermediate	- Organizes information - Analyzes and interprets information
Proficient	- Uses a wide variety of sources - Filters information for relevancy - Incorporates information literacy strategies into lesson design
Sub-Category: <b>Integration, Student Learning, and Classroom Management</b> 	
Intermediate	- Locates resources appropriate for integrating technology into lesson design
Proficient	- Selects and implements internet resources appropriately in lesson design - Selects and uses effective classroom management techniques
